




School Delay and Emergency Cancellation Decision Information

How School District Team Makes Decisions

Information to Make Informed Decisions

- Staff reviews updated weather information, Caltrans and County road, PG&E information prior to making decisions related to school delay and/or cancelation.
- Office of Emergency Services (State/Local)
- State and County road conditions
- National Weather Service

Assessing Conditions in Realtime

-Assess conditions across geographically diverse County. MCUSD has schools, staff, students, and parents at the following elevations: 1500 feet, 2000 feet, 4000 feet.

-MCUSD Transportation Department will assess conditions the night prior to an anticipated event.

-MCUSD Transportation Department will assess condition the morning of an event to determine if conditions call for a delay and/or cancelation.



Decision Time

-Based on all feedback, MCUSD Transportation Director will recommend a course of action to the Superintendent based on real time information.

- **Student and staff safety are always at the forefront of all decisions.**

-Decisions to delay and/or cancel school typically are made at or around **6:00 am** before busses leave to pick up students.

-Every effort is made for decisions to delay school to be made by **6:00am**, and every effort is made to make decisions to close school by **8:00 am**, if a prior decision to delay was made.
